With your commitment, 2018 can be a year that sees real progress in advancing the rights of women and girls.

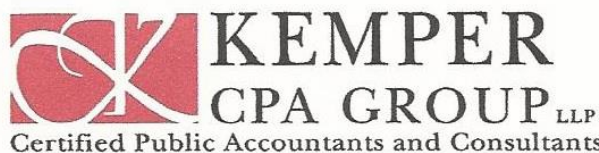

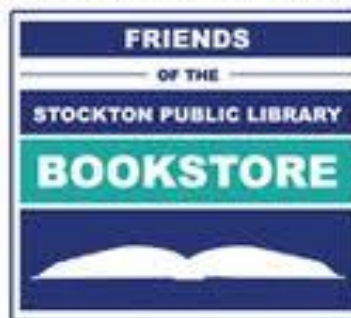
